#### **Topic:**

## Mathematics work this half term:

In Maths at the moment, we are working on statistics, looking at graphs, pictograms, tally charts and bar charts. We are also getting ready for SATs by practising our arithmetic skills 3 times daily. We are maths-magicians!

#### Our targets are:

- I can count in my multiples of 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 10s
- I can add a 2 digit number in a column
- I can subtract a 2 digit number in a column
- I can multiply by 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10
- I can divide by 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10
- I can tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes
- I can read and interpret data on graphs.
