Weekly Update

Nursery—This week, Nursery, have been reading the book 'All Are Welcome' and talking about how everyone is welcome in their class and no one is left out. The children then decorated figures of themselves and stuck them onto our world.



Reception – This week in Reception they have been learning about how families celebrate together. Some children have made birthday cards, decorated celebration cakes, and counted candles!



Year 1 - All children have had a great time singing nursery rhymes this week. They have explored many different nursery rhymes, including those that teach us to count, those that tell us a story, and those with actions.



Year 2 - In Science, year 2 have been learning about micro and macro habitats. They went out to look at the macro habitat in the woods at school, and found lots of invertebrates living in the micro habitats too!

Year 3 - the children have been super scientists and have been testing the reaction of different rock types when an acidic solution was applied. They tested lots of different rocks and were able to spot the sedimentary rock, limestone!

Year 4 - have had lots of fun this week rehearsing their explanation text. They are learning 'How to identify a living thing' and have used actions to help us remember the text. Ask us about MRS GREN and we will be able to tell you all of the characteristics living things have.



Year 5 - This week in year 5, they have been doing hot seating activities to help with their writing.

Year 6— had the most fantastic day cooking in DT. We prepared and enjoyed three street food dishes from around the world: Burritos, Pitta bread and hummus, and Samosas. The children learnt safe cutting and peeling skills and learnt how to knead and prove bread dough.

Dolphin - In Dolphin 2 they have been observing closely plants and leaves to see how they are similar or different. We have been using magnifying glasses to see things in more detail. We know that a magnifying glass makes things bigger.
