Reception – Reception have been playing team games in PE. The children have taken what they have learnt into their outdoor times and started playing a game of 'What's the Time Mr Wolf?'

Year 1 - We have been developing our drawing skills, this week. We had such a good time drawing a dog, using skills such as cross hatching, zig zagging and using different amounts of pressure with a range of tools.



Year 2 - In our geography lesson this week, we carried out some fieldwork by going on a short walk to look at the human features in our local area.

Year 3 - This week year 3 have been expanding their knowledge in French! We have also started looking at an explanation text all about fossils in our writing.

Year 4 - In music, year four had to multitask by singing and performing a range of actions at the same time! They used claves to perform a famous rock song – We Will Rock You!

Year 5 - In Design and Technology, Year 5 made a flatbread and garlic butter, Smorrebrod (a Danish open sandwich) and finally a Mezze bowl.

Year 6 - This week, Year 6 had great fun planning their own traditional tales. They used a story map to make changes to the story of Hansel and Gretel, adding in some new fairytale

creatures.



Dolphin - Dolphin Pod 2 have been learning about road safety. We have looked at different types of crossings and where the safest place to cross is. Then we acted out crossing the road and using crossings, what all the colours mean on the traffic lights.
