Weekly Update

Nursery— This week we have been making the most of the lovely weather, and have been doing lots of outside learning. We have been building sandcastles in our sandpit, making sure the plants have plenty of water and making our own dens. We have continued to enjoy our weekly Bikeability sessions too.

Reception—There's been a lot of excitement in reception since the butterflies have broke out of their chrysalis'. We have heard some interesting discussions happening amongst the children and many have been even more inspired to create their symmetrical butterfly paintings in the event of these transformations

Year 1— we have dived into the fantastic world of fractions. We've looked at splitting wholes into halves and halves into quarters. As always with fractions this has allowed us to play some engaging games that the children have loved. It is always brilliant to see the children discover and enjoy a new element of maths. Especially one that means they will now be able to equally share out parts of a juicy orange!

Year 2— For Design and Technology, we built and tested a simple vehicle. We remembered the vocabulary for wheels and axles.

Year 3 — This week year 3 have started their new science topic, light. We started off by looking at the purpose of light and how it helps us to see. The children made light boxes to investigate this.

Year 4— Year 4 are learning about money in maths. We are learning how to convert pounds to pence, compare money, estimate and calculate and how to problem solve using money. It would be really useful if parents could support their children at home by using money in real life situations.

Year 5— This week, our Year 5 classes have been to Into University to take part in a focus day all about lifecycles – which is their current Science topic. We took part in a carousel where we found out about: different animals gestation periods; skeletons and muscles; genetics and we made comparisons between the life cycles of a human and a frog.

Year 6— To prepare for our Reading SATs paper, we have been focussing on a variety of reading skills as well as practising how to fluently read with pace, by echo reading and stop and swap activities.

Dolphin Pod— Dolphin Pod 2 We have been looking at Food and nutrition, how food affects our senses. We learnt what the five senses are and we can identify flavours of food. We can explain why our bodies need vitamins and minerals.
