<p><u>English- Spelling</u> Learn your spellings every week.</p> <p></p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Can you go on a walk around your local area and look for human and physical features. Are there any physical features that are in fact human?</p> <p></p>	<p><u>History</u> Can you make a poster comparing the different ways of life of the Romans and the Celts. Look at your knowledge organiser to help you!</p> <p></p>	<p><u>English-Writing</u> For the love of writing, write your class text as it is, remembering your super spelling, punctuation, and grammar skills.</p> <p></p>
<p><u>Art</u> Can you make a 3D model of a Roman building. You can use any resources at home for example, recycling materials, plasticine etc.</p> <p></p>	<p><u>Computing</u> Create a presentation of your choice using your chosen media. This might be a video, slide show or photo montage.</p> <p></p>	<p><u>English-Reading</u> Read a minimum of 4 times a week - including at least once with an adult - and record the reading in your Reading Record.</p> <p></p>	<p><u>PSHE</u> Write a recipe for a successful relationship. E.g a sprinkle of trust, a dollop of laughter, a spot of friendship.</p> <p></p>
<p><u>Science</u> Draw and label the parts of a flower. Can you remember their purposes? Look at your knowledge organiser to help you!</p> <p></p>	<p><u>English-Reading</u> Complete the weekly comprehension tasks, which have been sent home by your class teacher.</p> <p></p>	<p><u>RE</u> Write a list of all the responsibilities you have. E.g. tidying your room, helping with the washing up.</p> <p></p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Complete the weekly maths homework set by your teacher. This should be a mixture of arithmetic and reasoning.</p> <p></p>
