Maths

This half term we will be focusing on numbers 1 – 5; recognising them, writing them, and counting out the correct quantity. We will use 2D shapes to make our own houses, and will begin to talk about length, height and capacity.

Understanding of the World

Our focus this half term is on ourselves, our families and our community. We will be thinking about what we can see and do in our area, including making maps of Aspley.



Phonics

During the Autumn Term we will be focusing on our listening skills, identifying different household and animal sounds. We will also be clapping the syllables in different words, identifying rhyming pairs and segmenting and blending 'Robbie the Robot's' words.
