### **Weekly Update**

Reception— Thursday 10th October was 'Hello Yellow' day. It's a Young Minds charity day in which we discuss children's mental health and promote awareness of the matter. To do this, everyone has been encouraged to wear something yellow. As you can imagine, in Reception, it leads to a very bright classroom! The children and the staff have had such fun showing off our buttery yellows, our mad mustards, our laughing lemons, and our brilliant blondes! As an event, it's a great opportunity to teach our little ones about the importance of mental health and to understand that they are valued as individuals. It can be a tricky topic at this age, however we've had some lovely contributions from our brilliant buttercups!

**Year 1**— This week we have been learning about mechanism in D&T. We have been making our own moving pictures with previous lessons on weaving and sliders to help us create the moving picture. This has been super fun!

Year 2— Our PE focus this half term has been ball skills. This week, we have been practising how to throw a ball at a target. We experimented with different ways of throwing the ball through the hoop (target) and discussed which way was the easiest.

Year 3 — In English we have been learning how to find a fossil in our non-fiction information text. We have been learning all about the features of an information text, ready to write our own next week! We know that information texts have a clear title, so the reader knows what they are reading and learning about, an introduction, to introduce the topic, subheadings to organise our paragraphs clearly and a fun 'Did you know?' fact. We love sharing our knowledge in the fun fact section!

**Year 4**— Year 4 have been cooking this week as part of their Design and Technology curriculum. They rolled dough to make pizza, kneaded dough to make bread rolls and grated, cooked and blended vegetables to make soup! After showing off their super cooking skills, they all tasted their creations and it was thumbs up all round!

**Year 5**— This week, we have completed some activities for Hello Yellow Day. The children took part in a circle game where they gave each other positive compliments. It was lovely to hear so many kind words.

**Year 6**—In Year 6, we have celebrated Hello Yellow Day. We discussed the importance of mental health, and we've learnt how to articulate our emotions. We have created a chatterbox game to help us discuss strategies for improving our mental health. We then designed our own mental health superheroes.
