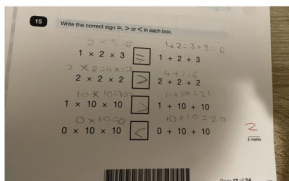
Year 6 Shout out

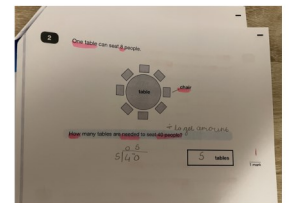
DEMI-LEIGH!

Brilliant notes above each number sentence help her to be really sure and earn two marks!



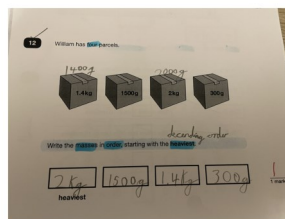
COREY!

UMAIR!

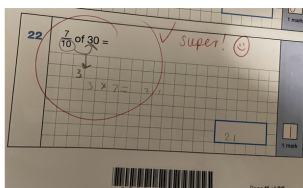
Great idea to use the picture to convert all the boxes to grams! And super note to remind him to go with the greatest weight first.
