Year 1 children will be expanding their number value knowledge by learning numbers to 50. The children will be using number lines, number squares and physical resources to support their learning.

Computing

Our computing curriculum will see the children learn how to safe when using our ICT equipment, a school and home. The children will be learning what to do if they see something unsafe.
