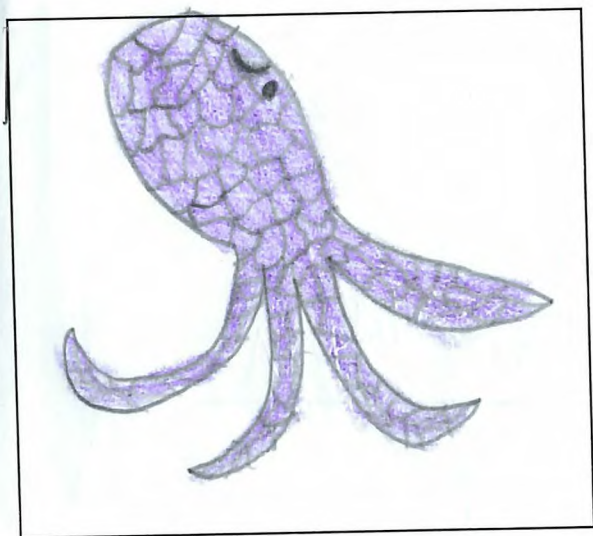


# Everything you need to know about Octeleons One of the most strategic beasts on Earth

Appearance:

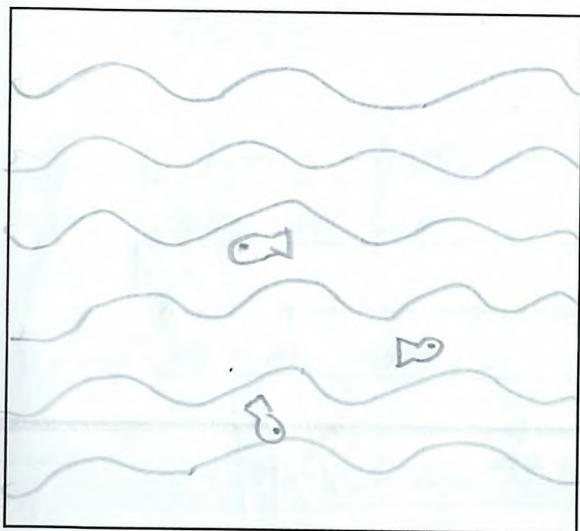
The Octeleon - which is a remarkable

creature - possesses a range of characteristics. Its elongated tentacles are perfect to swim in water and run along land - this makes it an amphibious animal. As a result of both its octopus and chameleon ancestry, it has an unusual and slightly frightening appearance to behold.



### Habitat:

The largest camps of Octoleons have been spotted in human habitats (where 57% of its prey comes from). The Octoleon can



thrive on both land and water; this adaptability allows it to easily capture and consume its prey.

Diet:



The Octoleon is a brutal, carnivorous beast. It devours a range of animals: fish, which makes up 21% of its diet; humans, which make up 57%; and many other animals, which make up the remaining 22%. When they are hunting, they use their ability to camouflage and their tentacles to capture their prey.
